The free lemonade stand kits include all of the essentials for a successful lemonade stand including signs, campaign brochures and bracelets, lemonade packets, and more. The kits can be picked up at the Salina Regional Health Foundation office beginning Tuesday, June 1. The Foundation is located on the first floor of the new patient tower at the hospital, 400 S. Santa Fe.

The Donna L. Vanier Children’s Center will serve as home to three separate, but inter-related children’s programs, including Salina Regional Health Center’s Infant-Child Development Program, and two community programs, Child Advocacy and Parenting Services (CAPS) and the Salina Child Care Association.
